
This 2001 Shiraz, from 150-year-old vines and aged in new American oak, boasts an inky purple colour with aromas of roasted earth, blackberry liqueur, leather, and spice. Dense, full-bodied, and viscous, this sensational wine is drinkable young and yet last for two decades.



Elderton COMMAND Shiraz 2016

A bit tighter and more focused than the 2015, the 2016 Command Single Vineyard Shiraz looks to have a bit more tannic richness and length, even if it's not quite as opulent or plush. It's still full-bodied and packed with dark fruit flavours and enough oak to give it shape and length. One of the best Commands I've tried.

A bit leafier than the stellar 2016, the 2017
Ashmead Single Vineyard Cabernet
Sauvignon is still a fine, elegant example of
Barossa Cabernet. Medium-bodied, it's smooth
and streamlined, with a somewhat linear feel
and a crisp, gently tannic finish.







The 2003 Shiraz Barossa Valley, from 40-year-old vines, is super-intense with an opaque purple hue. It has a full-bodied bouquet of creme de cassis, blueberry, creosote, smoke, and oak. This high-alcohol, limited production wine offers purity, intensity, and a multi-dimensional personality.

The 2004 Shiraz/Viognier The Relic (93% Shiraz, 7% Viognier) is an exotic, flamboyant wine with inky/purple color, powerful full body, and sweet notes of blue and black fruits, flowers, and subtle oak. Aged 20 months in old French oak, it has a blockbuster mid-section, long finish, and is made by Dan Standish. Drink now or cellar for 15+ years.



A glass of Tapanappa Cabernet Shiraz is vibrant cerise with layered aromas of mulberry, clove, blackberry, and liquorice. It offers sweet fruit flavors, dry, dusty tannins that turn creamy, and a long, smoky finish.


Elegant, smooth and supple with a spicy, floral perfume of raspberries, redcurrants, cloves and cinnamon, over suggestions of sweet vanilla/cedary oak and a hint of raisins. It opens slowly, becoming more juicy, fleshy and silky, presenting a restrained array of sweet cherry/berry fruit knit tightly with fine, bony tannins.

The 2006 Cabernet Sauvignon Brookman Vineyard is flavourful and will be approachable young, drinking well through 2026. While the vintage wasn't as exceptional as 2005, some 2006s may surpass 2005s. Clarendon Hills 2006 Syrahs are superb, less structured, more forward, and early approachable.





Intense aroma of smoked prune, plum, bay leaf, mint. Steady strong body with medium plus acidity, finish by oaky hints and sandy rough tannin, good Australia Shiraz.




